Additional Donor Opportunities

- A special donor recognition will be placed at the entry way to the park. The donor's name, company name or the organization name of the special donor will be listed as follows:

\$5,000.00 or more Platinum Level	\$1,000.00 or more Silver Level
\$2,000.00 or more Gold Level	\$ 500.00 or more Bronze Level
- Assist in funding any of the following: 1 of the 5 service memorials, the POW/MIA memorial, the Wall of Honor listing all Jackson County service members killed in action, 1 of the 6 educational kiosks or the center statue for the memorial circle. Donors of \$5,000 or more will have the donor name or business name located on or adjacent to the item sponsored.
- Sponsor a black granite bench with a donation of \$3,500. Donor will have choice of personalized inscription on top of the bench.

Progression of the Park:

- Feb. 2014: VFW Post 6073 Initiates action to acquire an Army tank
- May 2014: VFW Post 6073 & American Legion Post 30 form a committee to research the possibilities of building a Veterans Memorial Park on veteran owned property.
- July 2014: Fund raising begins.
- Sep. 2014: Steering Committee formalized: Scottsboro Mayor; JC Commission Chairman; Chamber of Commerce President and VFW & A/L members.
- Sep. 2014: Tank is transported to Scottsboro and placed on display.
- Nov. 2015: Veterans Memorial Park of Jackson County, Inc. is incorporated and accepted as an IRS 501 (c) 3 non-profit organization.
- May 2016: Ground breaking ceremony
- Sep. 2016: Construction begins to prepare for the Monument circle, sidewalks and paver walkway
- Nov. 2016: Received additional military displays; 37mm canon and a Nike-Ajax missile
- Oct . 2017: Special Dedication Ceremony – sand from battlefields around the world is mixed and then enshrined in a location below the center star of the memorial circle.
- May 2018: First orders of park benches and inscribed brick pavers are installed.
- Jul. 2018: Three Flag poles are installed
- Aug. 2018: Granite sign for front of park is installed
- Oct. 2018: Military displays are installed: 155m Howitzer; German field gun; 37mm field gun
- Nov. 2018: Ceremony to raise the flags for first time.
- Nov. 2018: Phase 2 begins. Fundraising to purchase and install monuments, Honor Wall, educational Kiosks and completion of phase 1 infrastructure.
